



WOMEN'S HEALTH BANNERS BORROWING GUIDELINES

DESCRIPTION

As part of women's health advocacy and promotion for the Victorian Women's Health Summit of July 2006, 10x collapsible banners were created with information on different women's health issues. Content was created by a range of representatives from the women's health services and health promotion agencies. The format of the banners, and their information-carrying capacity, ensure their usefulness in a variety of health promotion settings and activities.

Topics covered are:

1. Why women's health: an overview
2. Women and alcohol
3. Women and financial security
4. Women and heart disease
5. Women and mental health
6. Women and sexual and reproductive health
7. Women and cancer
8. Women and social connectedness
9. Women and tobacco
10. Women and violence

NB: Banner number 1, Why women's health: an overview, establishes the context for all other banners. It is recommended that banner number 1 is borrowed in conjunction with any other health topic banner.

LOAN FROM CRC COLLECTION

Consistent with Women's Health Victoria's 'Clearinghouse Information Service: Operations Policy', each banner is available for loan following their use at the July Summit 2006. Borrowers can make requests via the usual methods: email, phone, or online direct from the database.

The loan period is 1x week by default, however individual borrower needs will determine extensions to this time period, including the needs of rural services. An extension can be granted at the discretion of Women's Health Victoria Clearinghouse depending on prior bookings.

The responsibility for arranging transportation of the banner/s from Women's Health Victoria and their subsequent return rests with the borrower. Any transport costs associated with the circulation of the banners are borne by the borrower.

During the borrowing period, the borrower is responsible for the care and protection of the banners. Should the banners be lost, stolen or damaged while on loan, the borrower will bear the cost of replacement or repair in negotiation with Women's Health Victoria.

ELIGIBLE BORROWERS

Eligible borrowers are all women's health services and organisations associated with women's health. Other eligible borrowers will be determined by Women's Health Victoria Clearinghouse on a discretionary basis.
